NB	A NB Nurse Practitioner is authorized to prescribe drugs as follows: drugs listed in Schedule 1 of the National Association of Pharmacy Regulatory Authorities (NAPRA) National Drug Schedules (NDS) www.napra.ca/pages/scheddules.search.aspx . A NP is authorized to prescribe vaccines in accordance with the immunization standards for NB Public Health as outlined in the <i>New Brunswick Immunization Handbook</i> and the <i>Canadian Immunization Guide</i> as revised from time to time and vaccine means any biological product used in the NB immunization program (Oct 9, 2003). Non prescription drugs can be obtained without prescription however.
